Appropriate seasonal clothing for work, school and everyday use: <i>Clean clothing, in good condition, for all members of the family (including proper footwear)</i>			
Baby items, as needed: <i>baby food, clothing, diapers, infant and car seats, and cribs</i>			
Food available on arrival: <i>Culturally appropriate, ready-to-eat food, plus 1 days' worth of additional food supplies (including baby food, as needed)</i>			
Food within 1 day of arrival: <i>Food or food allowance at least equivalent to the food stamp allocation for that family unit and continued food assistance until receipt of food stamps or until individual/ family is able to provide food for themselves</i>			
Additional items appropriate to family size and composition: <i>For example, large families should receive enough cookware to prepare a meal for all individuals</i>
