When it came time for elementary student Catalina* to go to school at United Community Center (UCC), she most always complained of tummy aches and headaches. The LSS School-Centered Mental Health (SCMH) Therapy Team worked with Catalina, her parents and UCC teachers/counseling staff to find that she also had a lack of focus in school and little-to-no peer relationships. A combination of SCMH family coaching and therapy services coupled with growth mindset instructions/practice in therapy and at school, empowered Catalina to return to school symptom-free, make new friends and develop positive teacher relationships.

A Response to the Opioid Crisis, LSS Aspen Center Celebrates Recovery

On January 14th, Héctor Colón along with many partners, donors, colleagues and friends, celebrated the virtual grand opening of LSS Aspen Center. A video tour of this very special event can be found at www.lsswis.org/our-impact.

LSS Aspen Center is one of 17 addiction recovery programs offered to Wisconsin and Upper Michigan residents. When a gap in affordable medically supervised treatment in the community was identified, LSS worked in collaboration with Waukesha County in co-creating the Aspen Center plan. The newly renovated, 23,000 square foot residential facility offers 24/7 care to women and men including one-on-one, group and family therapy, and skills development. Clients are already experiencing the love, compassion and care through our servant-led staff.
